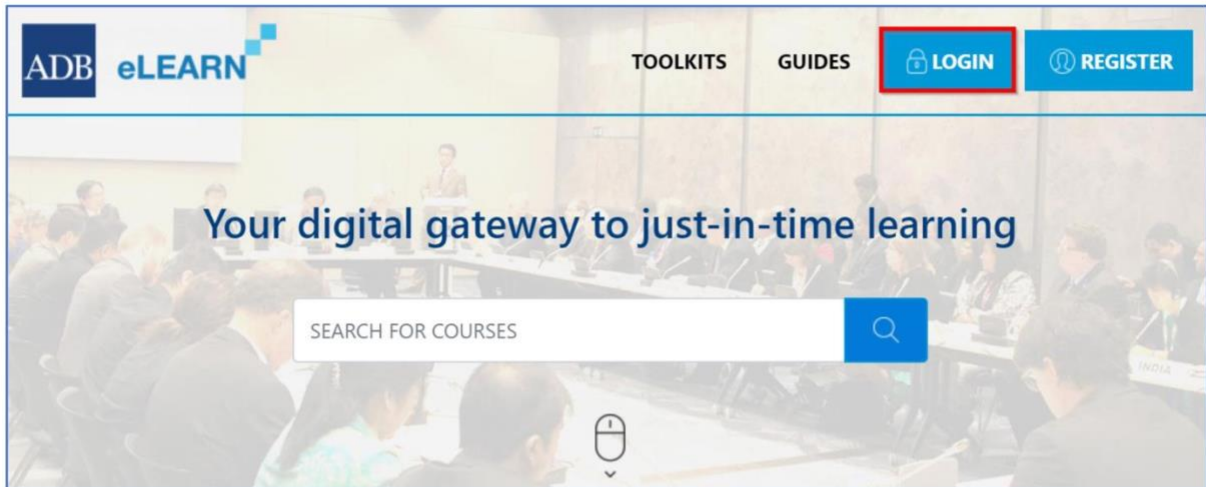


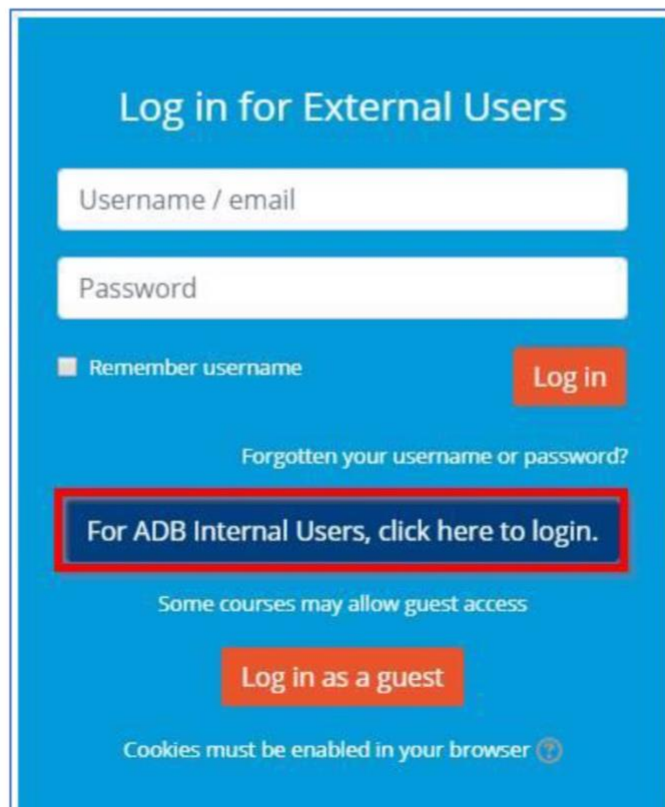
Accessing eLearning Courses (ADB eLearn)

For New ADB Staff

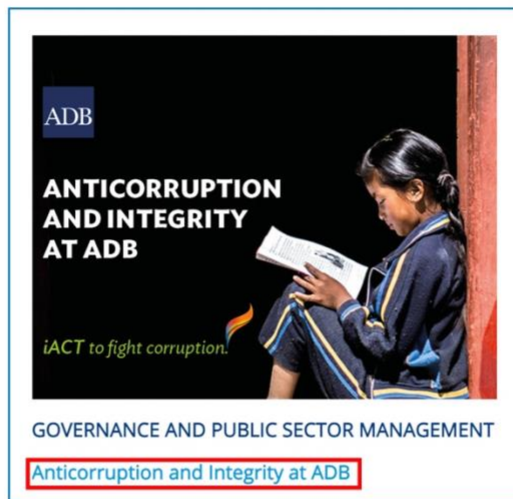
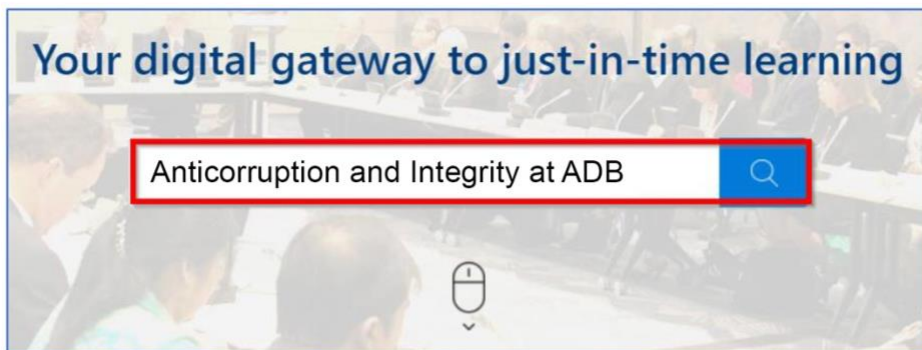
1. Log in to your ADB-issued computer using your ADB account.
